

CDCO Minutes

June 8, 2021

Present: Trish M (Chair), Tom O (Data Coordinator; Group Information Coordinator), Fred F (Day Scheduler; Night Owl Coordinator), Ed M (Treasurer), Justyn B (Literature), Lois M (D14 COR), Cyndi D (D13 DCR/COR), and Jessica W (Alternate Treasurer).

Chair: The short form of Tradition 6 was read. Office running well. We will discuss reopening the Office under new business.

Secretary: Absent. Chip B sent minutes for May via email. They were reviewed and accepted.

Treasurer: Report reviewed and accepted. A \$350 cash contribution (Cohoes Wed. Evening Group) made in the office was not retrieved by the treasurer in time to be deposited in May. It will appear in the June report.

Day Scheduler/Night Owl Coordinator: Need someone for the 5 to 8 p.m. Wednesday shift at the office. Pat L can no longer do it because of work schedule change. Also, might need a night owl for every other Saturday night. Have to check with him to see if he is still available.

Group Information Coordinator: Many meeting changes coming in because groups are reopening in-person. Giving these to Ed M and also sending them to HMB. Events postings are up to date.

Data Coordinator: We had 172 calls in May, the most in any month since December 2014.

Literature: We sold \$1,369 in AA literature and \$372 in medallions. Tried to make literature deposits at Cap Com on May 29, but they were closed, so those deposits will go into the June report.

IT Coordinator: CDCO Website home page changed to prominently display Helpline telephone number within the header image at the "top" of the page. CDCO-Net volunteer website will now automatically send meeting change information called in to the individual district records keeper.

Old Business: no old business.

New Business: Accepting District 3 (Greene County) into the CDCO was discussed. They had approached Ed M at an HMB event, saying that they were unhappy with their answering service and would possibly like to join us. They apparently have not voted on it yet at their district. We decided to ask their representative(s) to come to the July CDCO business meeting with 12th step lists for men and women for their district and an openness to help with CDCO business as best they can. If they do, in fact, want to join us, we will vote at the July meeting on whether to accept them on a 3-month trial basis. **(Continued, next page.)**

New Business (cont.): Fred F will contact the volunteers who cover the day shifts at the Office to determine if they are willing to take their shifts at the Office again (to reopen the Office). Some will have to be trained in using the Square. Meanwhile, if two volunteers on a given day are willing to come in, the Office will be open that day. Curbside pickups for literature, etc. will continue until complete reopening.
