2020 was a challenging year for the CDCO and the individual A.A. meetings. With the advent of the COVID-19 pandemic, financial activity in the districts slowed dramatically as groups were largely not meeting in person and were grappling with the challenges posed by alternative meeting methods- most notably online meetings.

Without a physical basket to exercise the collection part of the 7th Tradition, many groups saw their prudent reserves drop as they maintained obligations such as rent for meeting space.

The Central Office delivered a workshop co-sponsored by HMB Area 48, titled: <u>The 7th Tradition</u> <u>in the Digital World</u>. The workshop sought to help A.A. meetings understand the mechanics of establishing a Tax ID, a group bank account, and a digital payment method. This allowed some groups to accept donations via digital payment methods such as PayPal, Venmo, and others. Other groups had already adopted the practices on their own.

The year saw us introduce a new website which allowed us to distance ourselves from traditional services such as paper telephone directories to reach more persons in need of assistance. Our own adoption of an online digital contribution and payment system, coupled with an online "Plea for Help" was helpful in our ending the year in the black, albeit barely.

Without the help and support of meetings, individuals, and the districts themselves, the CDCO would have faced a more challenging year. We adopted some changes to help weather the pandemic. We were able to convert our Business insurance to monthly payments without penalty, and to eliminate our office water service. Rent, Internet, and telephone continued to be our largest expenses for 2020.

Initially, New York State guidelines required us to close our office. Literature, medallions, and cards were no longer able to be purchased in-person. We adjusted our daytime volunteers to work from home in a virtual environment. The A.A. hotline was never down – it was always available as ever-changing regulations were emerging.


To address these unexpected events, we were able to respond online. Our literature chair developed an online store as regulations were permitting restricted on-site volunteer work. We eventually opened the office for curbside pickup for items ordered online, as well as items ordered over the phone. The CDCO is currently open on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays for curbside service.

We also developed a private, secure website for volunteers to access all of the resource materials normally available in our physical office. This made hotline and other services in the virtual environment easier to deliver.

Last, a new form of digital communication has also been rolled out to replace the traditional full-page Newsletter. The Broken Bottle is now delivered in a more contemporary short form. The communications platform allows us to regularly send news and developments to our volunteers and our growing subscriber base. Sign up on our home page: AAalbanyNY.org.
